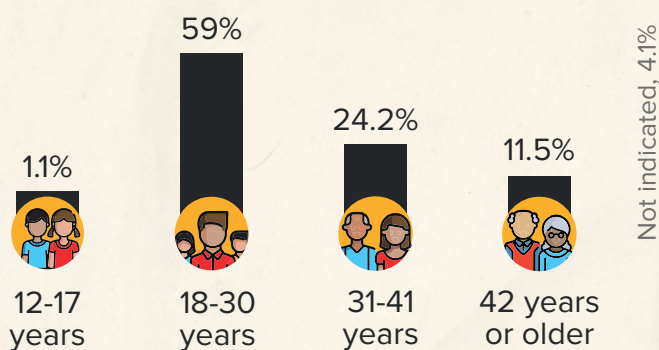

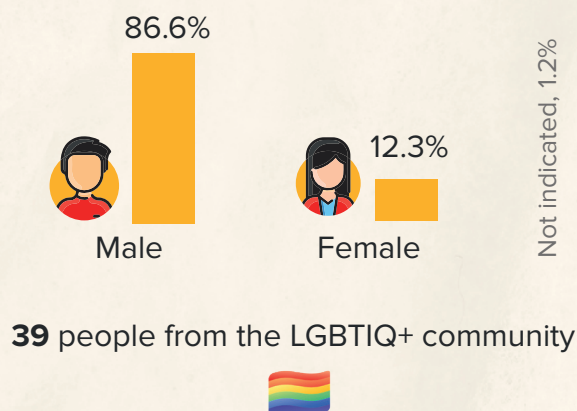

Age range

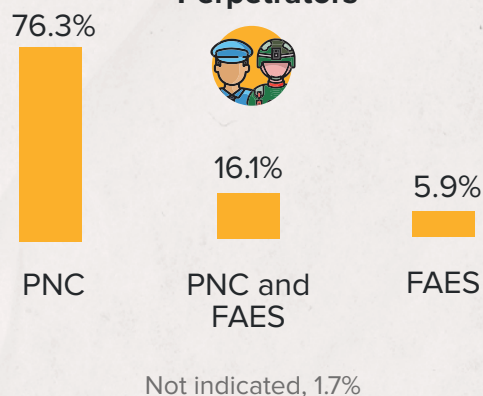


Gender of the victims



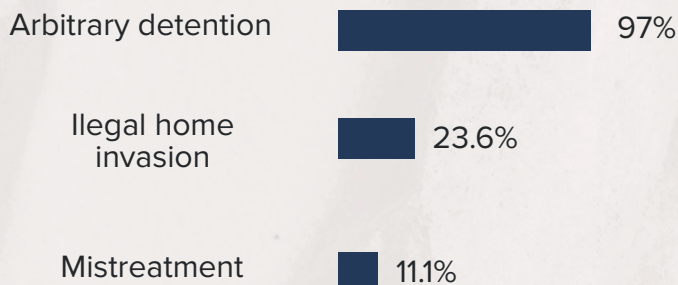

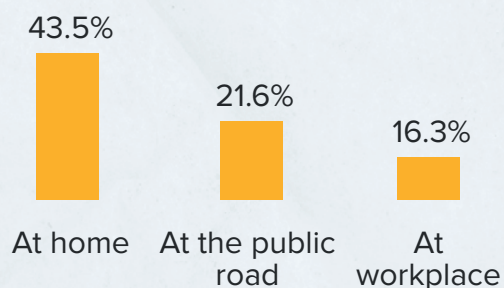

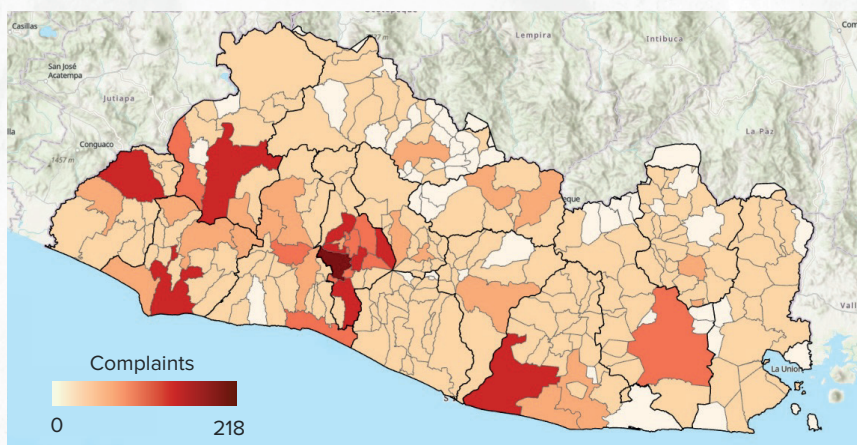

PLACE OF DETENTION

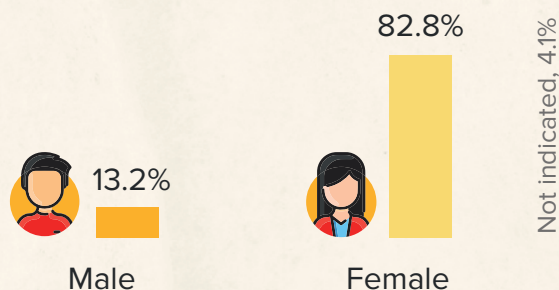


The main places of detention

People MISSING

In **102** of the cases, the families **did not know** the place
where the victim was detained at the time of filing
the complaint.

INTERNALLY displaced persons

Cristosal attended **133** internally forced displaced persons
due to violence during the period of the Exception Regime
